Attendance Policy & Educational Penalty Notices

A reminder that working within a Code of Conduct, the Local Authority can issue a penalty notice to parents or carers if a child has been absent without the permission from school.

You could receive a Penalty Notice if your child falls within one or more of these categories within a 12-week period:

- 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence with under 90% attendance.
- 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised absence.
- persistently arrives late for school after the close of registration.

If you have any concerns about your child's attendance or you are experiencing any difficulties, please contact Mrs Taylor.
