Christmas Clothing Exchange

Christmas Goody Bag



From Friday 1st December mini Christmas Sacks containing a small selection of Christmas goody's will go on sale. These will be available to purchase for £3 each at lunchtime from the school council members, delivering to classrooms. They will not be available to purchase from the school office. Children will need to bring the correct money into class, in an envelope marked 'PTFA Goody Bag' with their name on.
