This year, we are teaming up with RJT Solicitors, who are running a competition to encourage our children to make our world a happier, healthier place to live.

To enter:

Reception, Year 1 & Year 2

Draw a picture or design a poster based on this years' theme of 'planet v plastics'

Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6

Write a short story of between 300-500 words on the topic 'planet v plastics'

One entry per child and on the back of their entry they should write their full name, school and year group.

The closing date for all entries will be on **Friday 7th June 2024**. The winners will be chosen by Rachel Taylor and her colleagues at RJT Solicitors on the basis of creativity and relevance to the subject. There will be a first prize of a **£100 Smyths Toys Voucher** and a second prize of a **£50 Smyths Toys Voucher** for each category.

The winners will then be invited to collect their prize at RJT Solicitors in Standish for refreshments and the presentation of their prize.
