### **YEAR 5 VISIT TO WARNER BROS. STUDIO TOUR! OCTOBER 2019**

When your child is in Year 5, the context for learning in autumn term 1 will be 'Potions and Spells'. In order to further their learning around the context, and the study of Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, they will have the fantastic opportunity to visit Warner Bros. Studio Tour of The Making of Harry Potter, Leavesden. This will take place on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October.**

The children will have the chance to step onto iconic sets such as the Great Hall and the Forbidden Forest, see up close the intricate detail hidden in every costume and discover how the visual and special effects team created filmmaking magic on screen! They will also be taking part in an instructional writing workshop where they will create written instructions for a film animal of their choice to perform and discover the secrets of how the animal characters in the Harry Potter film series were trained.

The cost of the trip will be £42.50 per child to cover the cost of entrance to Harry Potter World, a workshop, the coach and insurance. The trip has been set up on ParentPay for you to pay in instalments if you wish, **however in order to confirm the booking with Warner Bros. the first payment of £17.50 (the cost of the admission ticket) is required by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March.** The final balance is due by the 12<sup>th</sup> July.

We will be leaving school at 6.30 am and we will return to school at approximately 8:00 pm. **Please can you ensure that your child is at school for 6.15 am in order that the register may be taken and we can leave promptly.**

As we will be leaving school early, please can you provide your child with a packed lunch. You may also want to give them some snacks as it will be a long day! Please can we ask, however, that you do not include any nut products or fizzy drinks. Children can bring spending money for the gift shop, however they will be responsible for looking after their own money. You may wish to look on the official website for guidelines on prices.

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1988, there is no obligation to contribute to the cost and no child will be omitted from the activity because his/her parents are unwilling or unable to pay, however it will be necessary to have substantial parental contributions in order that the activity takes place. If there are insufficient voluntary contributions the event will be cancelled. Please let the school know if there is a genuine case of hardship. The matter will be dealt with in strictest confidence.

Please visit ParentPay to confirm your child's place and pay the initial deposit, by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March.
